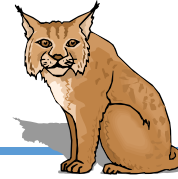

Governor's announcement regarding K12 Vaccinations

The state has yet to release an official public health order to this effect. When they do, the ADLA will review it to understand the implications and applicability for our Catholic schools. The ADLA Department of Catholic Schools will provide further information when we know more.

COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR STUDENTS AGES 12+: If your child is vaccinated, please send us a copy of his/her vaccination status to keep on file in the school. As with all files, this is will be kept private and secure. Note: Students who have been fully vaccinated won't have to quarantine if they have been exposed to COVID and have their vaccination status on file in the school.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS: Per LA County and beginning 10/15, all school volunteers must meet all of the following requirements prior to activity or event:

1. Provide negative COVID test OR provide proof of being fully vaccinated
2. Be fingerprinted AND VIRTUS compliant
3. Have on file a signed *Guidelines for Adults Working with Minors Form* AND *Volunteer Agreement Form*

HEALTH REMINDER: If your child feels sick, please **DO NOT** give him/her medicine and send to school. Refer to the *2021-22 Beatitudes In-Person Parent-Student Handbook* published on SchoolSpeak and our website; and call the office for guidance.
